On-site Medical and Emergency Response Services

FSA provides on-site medical and emergency services solutions across Australia. This year we will provide approximately 15,000+ people days of Paramedics, Nurses, Emergency Services Officers, Security Officers and Safety Advisors across Australia to the Mining, Oil and Gas, Construction, and Renewable Energy Industries.

FSA provides clients with a holistic and integrated approach to managing the provision of onsite emergency response and medical services. We support our remote on-site capability with industry leading equipment and technology such as our – Emergency Response vehicle fleet of 4WD Ambulances and Fire Appliances, our remote video telemedicine assistance technology, our leading medisim (pre-hospital care medical simulation equipment), the latest in virtual reality fire training technology, and our training division incorporate realistic emergency response and fire training grounds to ensure continuous professional development for our personnel.

FSA has ISO9001-2015 Quality Accreditation for the supply and management of remote Emergency Response and Medical Services. FSA has over 100 employees across Australia employed in Medical and Emergency Services roles. FSA works with our clients to ensure an adherence to Zero Harm policies and our goal of making the work place a safer environment for all.

Our onsite emergency response and medical services are supported by formalised Standard Operating Policies and Procedures (SOPP's) and senior operational management, provide a seamless interface and cover the following services:

- · Development of client specific SOPP's.
- Provision of Paramedics, Nurses and GP's (interim and long term).
- · Provision of Emergency Services Officers.
- Provision of Mine Site Compliant 4WD Ambulances and 4WD Fire Appliances.
- Poisons Permits in cooperation with our medical partners, with 24/7 on call assistance and telehealth options.
- Clinic design and fit-out, Procurement of drugs and disposables.
- Emergency response equipment.
- Emergency Response, Medical, and Safety Training (Nationally recognised and awareness training options through our training division).
- Thoroughly tested contract mobilisation and management processes.

Complimenting our Medical And Emergency Response personnel and other services we have a full fleet of Ambulances, Quick Fire attack, and general Emergency Response vehicles. Our latest purpose-built 4WD Ambulances are fitted out with all necessary consumables and equipment including AED with 3 lead ECG, Oxygen Resuscitation Equipment, and First Aid/Trauma packs. Chargeback of any used consumables is at a cost-plus basis. These 4WD Ambulances have a 3rd ambulance attendant/paramedic door cut in, with air conditioning to the rear of the ambulance for the patient. This is particularly important in the Pilbara with high temperatures.
